Policy: Fire and Emergency Procedures

Fire emergency procedures and response protocols have been established for National Prep. We will conduct monthly fire drills. When the alarm sounds, District of Columbia law requires that everyone be evacuated from the building, even though it may be a drill or false alarm.

Tampering with any fire safety equipment, such as extinguishers, exit and emergency lights, smoke detectors, alarm devices, setting off false alarms, or failing to evacuate a building when an alarm is sounded are very serious offenses. Violators are subject to disciplinary action, which could include expulsion, and may be referred to civil authorities.
