### **Policy: Parental Visitation**

Parents are encouraged to visit the school during normal operating hours. All visitors are asked to sign in at the main office and obtain a visitors badge to ensure the safety and security of students and staff. Parents may either visit the classroom at the teacher's/school's invitation, or request to make a formal observation of a classroom. Making an appointment with the school at least two (2) days in advance of an observation is not only a courtesy and a requirement, but also it enables you to schedule the observation for the maximum benefit. Teachers cannot stop teaching to confer with parents who stop by without an appointment. Parents may schedule classroom observations by calling the Main Office. Staff will accompany visitors to the classroom. Teachers will be happy to discuss the observation at a mutually convenient time. Parents are also welcome to visit the cafeteria and eat lunch with their child. The school retains the authority to deny access to the school for any individual who has or may disrupt or disturb the learning environment or who lacks a valid or legal purpose for entering the school. Our shared commitment and cooperation is essential for the safety of our students and staff
