Policy: Responsibility to Adhere to Policies

By accepting enrollment at The National Collegiate Preparatory Public Charter High School, parents agree to abide by our school policies contained in this Handbook and/or issued by school officials. A parent's failure to abide by school policies may result in consequences applied to the parent, including, but not limited to, restrictions from campus visitation, barring parent participation in school events, and restrictions to sitting or parent committees. Parent failure to abide by school policies may jeopardize your child's enrollment status. Providing false or misleading information, and/or failing to meet all admissions requirements may disqualify your child from remaining enrolled. As a result of a failure to abide by school policies, the Co-Founders may designate an administrator to conduct an investigation for determining if additional review is necessary or if consequences should be imposed. The designated administrator may recommend and impose consequences. In addition, the Co-Founders may form an ad hoc committee of administrators and/or faculty to serve as a parent review board to review parent behavior and impose consequence, up to and including de-enrollment of a student from our school.
